RE: COVID-19 Community Precautions

In order for Pawnee Hills to remain the safe and beautiful place we all know and love, the Pawnee Hills Community Association Board of Directors is providing you with the following information and status updates that are pertinent during this trying time of the COVID-19 outbreak.

- Extra cleaning and sanitizing throughout the Pawnee Hills Clubhouse will be performed on a regular basis.
- The Clubhouse will still be open for gatherings of 10 OR LESS persons, especially for normal, monthly meetings. However, we will ask that everyone exercise “social distancing” at such gatherings per Center for Disease Control (CDC) recommendations to help limit the ability of the virus to spread. ADDITIONALLY, though the Clubhouse will be subject to extra cleaning and sanitizing as stated above, the Board of Directors recommends that your group do its own sanitizing wipe-downs both BEFORE and AFTER your meeting/event in order to have the best chance of success in reducing any possible contact with the virus.
- If you discover that any attendee at a “10 or less” event held at the Clubhouse is showing symptoms or was exposed to the COVID-19 virus within 14 days of your event, please notify the Board of Directors immediately at 303-646-0126. The Board will determine whether the Clubhouse will need to be closed for a period of time after such exposure.
- *Any reservations previously made for the Clubhouse which involve more than 10 persons expected to be in attendance are hereby cancelled until further notice. No new reservations for events that are for more than 10 persons will be accepted at this time.*
- Anyone in our community who has symptoms or who has been exposed to the COVID-19 virus is asked to self-quarantine for the protection of all in our Pawnee Hills community and also those in our larger neighborhood.
- We encourage everyone in our community to be aware of at least their surrounding neighbors to make sure no one is left without aid if needed.
- Please check the resources listed below for CDC recommendations to stop the spread of the virus and other information.
